

# Need Health Insurance? Indiana Has Programs to Help

There are over 20,000 individuals in Madison County that are uninsured, and many of them don't know they qualify for state programs that help with getting healthcare. Even families with working adults can qualify for programs.

The State of Indiana offers the following programs for free or at greatly reduced cost:

## Hoosier Healthwise:

Covers children and pregnant women

## Healthy Indiana Plan:

For working and non-working adults and their spouses

## Presumptive Eligibility:

Provides immediate coverage for pregnant mothers

## Pre-Existing Condition Insurance Plan:

Guarantees coverage for those that have been denied coverage from private insurers

## What do I need to apply:

- Proof of Income for the Past 30 Days
- Social Security Cards
- Birth Certificates for all Applicants
- Photo IDs for applicants over the age of 16.
- If applicant is not a US Citizen, proof of immigration status is required (immigration card, passport or birth certificate)
- Receipt or signed verification of any childcare paid in the last 30 days
- Proof of insurance, if any
- If pregnant, verification statement from healthcare provider with expected due date.
